Many rare qualities come together in this 22-acre site located above the valley floor at 800 feet on a secluded slope between St. Helena and Howell Mountain. The vineyard was planted by David Abreu in 1990 in order to create a classic Bordeaux-style blend. The Ecotone Proprietary Red exemplifies an ideal wine for Brion Wise, a combination of science and magic: a wine of the world that can only come from a well-chosen site that has been meticulously farmed.

Located in the “ecotone” between the valley and the mountain, as the name implies, this vineyard occupies one of those middle spaces, the hillside and benchland plantings increasingly recognized as sources of some of the best fruit in the Napa Valley, arguably in the world.

For 2021, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Sauvignon were co-fermented for a more complete integration. Red fruit and dark berry brings vibrant ripe flavors and aromatics to the powerful core, mingling with the dominant Cabernet flavors to create a satisfying tannin structure.
